Hello Lazy Days People!

It is already mid-year and things around the office are quiet in comparison to how things are in January, however I am keeping myself busy.

I enjoyed a nice week in Texas and Oklahoma with my husband's family and will be spending the first week of July in Canada with my Canadian family. Lots of grand children to hug a spoil!

Things are progressing on several major projects with the first steps in appealing the FEMA flood zone mapping underway. The drainage ditches being assessed to ensure they are as effective as possible and some community beautification plans are shaping up.

Compliance is being handled by myself and the board members in residence at this time of year so that is keeping us on our toes. Please remember that trees and shrubs must be kept neat even if you are in the North for the season, grass grows much faster during the summer wet season so it must be kept cut and power washing of homes is important too. Mold grows faster in the damp summer air so please keep on top of it or ask your home watch person to look at it and advise you if your home needs attention.

A reminder that Shareholders who have not yet paid the Special Assessment have until July 31st to make the payment. We have over 75% of payments in so far!

It is vital that we know who is living in the community. Yesterday, a package was delivered (medical equipment) for a person who is not an owner or an approved resident or registered guest. I could not identify who or where they were staying so the equipment was returned to the vendor. I have to pray it was not a vital item as the person who ordered it will have to go without it. Remember, renters must be approved prior to occupancy and can only rent for 6 months a year. Also, it is important to note that this is a "Single Family" park so renting out a room to an unrelated person, when you still reside here is also not permitted both by our rules and regulations and by the zoning of the community.

Grandparent and Family Scams

Here's how they work:

You get a call: "Grandma, I need money for bail." Or maybe an email from someone claiming to be your brother or a friend who says they're in trouble. They need money for a medical bill. Or some other kind of emergency. The caller says it's urgent — and tells you to keep it a secret.

But is the caller who you think it is? Scammers are good at pretending to be someone they're not. They can be convincing: **sometimes using information from social networking sites**, or hacking into your loved one's email account, all to make it seem more real. And they'll pressure you to send money before you have time to think.

Here's what to do:

- Stop. Check it out. Look up your family member's phone number yourself and call another family member to check out the story.
- Pass this information on to a friend. You may not have gotten one of these calls, but chances are, you know someone who will get one — if they haven't already.
